Consumer Protection Code.

São Paulo State Decree 8.468/76

Regulates the prevention and control of environmental pollution, provides for the competences of the State Company for Basic Sanitation Technology and Environmental Defense (CETESB), provides for the classification and classification and standard of water quality, establishes standards of release of effluents, conditions and requirements related to air quality, rules on protection and use and occupation of the soil, rules on waste disposal, rules on environmental licensing and provides for inspection and sanctions for violations of environmental legislation.

Municipal Resolution São Paulo AMLURB 107/17

Regulates the registration of operators of the City's Urban Cleaning System and the Electronic Waste Transport Control (CTR).

Normative Instruction IBAMA 12/21

Regulates authorisation to carry out the activity of distributing liquefied petroleum gas (LPG).

ANP Federal Resolution 958/23;

Regulates authorisation for the resale of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG).

4. Wooden Packing

Updated environmental licensing;

Full compliance with current Environmental Legislation, with emphasis on the following legal diplomas:

- Ordinance CPRN No. 24/06;

Provides for the License for transporting forest products and by-products of native origin.

Municipal Law No. 5,429/13

Establishes environmental control procedure for the use, storage or transport of forest products and by-products of native origin, including native charcoal, in the Municipality of Mogi Little.

Normative Instruction IBAMA 21/14

Establishes the National System for Controlling the Origin of Forest Products – SINAFLOR, with the aim of controlling the origin of wood, charcoal and other forestry products and by-products and integrating the respective data from the different federative entities.

Federal Normative Instruction (IN) ANVISA/IBAMA/SDA 2/15

Authorizes the use of methyl bromide in Brazil exclusively in phytosanitary treatment for quarantine purposes in import and export operations.

Federal Ordinance MAPA 514/22

Establishes the procedures for the inspection and phytosanitary certification of wooden packaging and supports intended for the packaging of goods imported into or exported from Brazil, and of the wooden components and parts used to make them.

IBAMA Federal Normative Instruction 2/24

Establishes the Simplified Authorisation Module within the National System for Controlling the Origin of Forest Products (Sinaflor+) as a tool for registering, analysing, issuing, managing and monitoring authorisations subject to simplified procedures at national level.
